A Lil' Acorn



When you look at an acorn, what do you see?

- I see an oak tree.
- I see a whole forest of oak trees.
- I see branches outstretched and root systems made up of intricate connections.

Given the right conditions, just as a tiny acorn has the potential within it to grow into a great oak, a human being has inbuilt potential to find success in any area of their life.

Acorns (like our students) are hardwired to reach great heights and expand into spaces they can hardly imagine from their starting places on the ground and in your classrooms. However, if they are not watered or hide in the shade, they do not grow. If they are surrounded with barren soil, they do not grow. If they are left among weeds, they do not grow.

YOU are EXPERT GARDENERS! You know exactly what to do.

Fill a pot with compost. Place an acorn in each, and cover with half an inch of soil. Water well. They will germinate immediately after sowing. Use mesh to guard against creatures. Choose a spot with an abundance of sunlight and room to grow.

- Next, nurture.
- Then, tend.
- Fertilize.
- Mulch.
- Water more.

Autumn, after all, is the ideal time to plant acorns.

- Protect.
- Nourish.
- Encourage.
- Care.
- Love.

To properly plant an acorn is good. *To ensure it survives is golden.*

In its first year, an acorn will only grow about six inches. In its second year, it will be ready to be re-planted in the ground. In three years, the newly planted tree will become fully established. By year six, the tree will become self-sustaining. And in 20 years? The oak tree will begin... producing... its own acorns.

Richard Riggleman Young Speech Coach AWARD

IHSSA Fine Arts Administrator AWARD

The Richard Riggleman Speech Coach Award was established to recognize young IHSSA Speech Coaches. The award consists of 1,000 per year, renewable for two consecutive years, for a total of \$3,000.

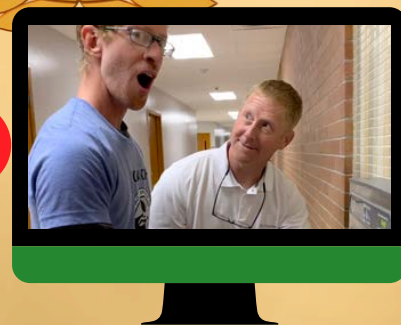
The recipient must be a second/third year teacher as of the start of the 2024-2025 school year and active in IHSSA activities. The award will be presented at the annual IHSSA Speech Coaches Convention. *Those interested may contact the IHSSA State Office for an application.*

The profile of the recipient should reflect the following disciplines: (1) must be in a second year residence of teaching at an Iowa School participating in the IHSSA; (2) show a commitment to coaching speech, large group events, individual events, and/or debate; (3) demonstrate excellence in the coaching of speech; (4) have past experience competing in high school or college speech; and (5) present a scholastic record with an emphasis in speech courses.

The Riggleman Award is the first of its kind that has been established with the IHSSA. Mr. Riggleman was an active IHSSA coach for over 30 years and still remains very active with IHSSA activities as a judge, State Debate Tournament manager, and manager for numerous State and District contests. Richard Riggleman was inducted into the IHSSA Hall of Fame in 1994.

The IHSSA is extremely grateful to Mr. Riggleman for his generous and continued support of the Iowa High School Speech Association.



This award will be given to one Administrator at the Fall Convention. The award was developed by the IHSSA Executive Committee to recognize those administrators in Iowa who go above and beyond the call of duty for IHSSA.

To receive this award an administrator must be nominated by their IHSSA coach. This nomination should be in letter form no longer than 2 pages and not less than 1. In the letter, each coach should state the reasons why this administrator should be recognized as the IHSSA Fine Arts Administrator of the year.

This person can be any administrator in your district. For example, Supt., Principal, AD, Assistant Principal, etc. They also must be an active administrator at this time. Be sure to include details such as their position in your school district and examples of their work to make the IHSSA better in your school district.

Deadline for application is Tuesday, September 24. Letters of recommendation can be sent at this time to the IHSSA State Office.

Please indicate on the outside of the envelope that it is a nomination for IHSSA Fine Arts Administrator of the year. Be sure to honor those who have made your life better through their support!

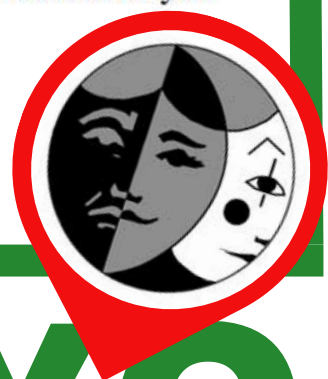
